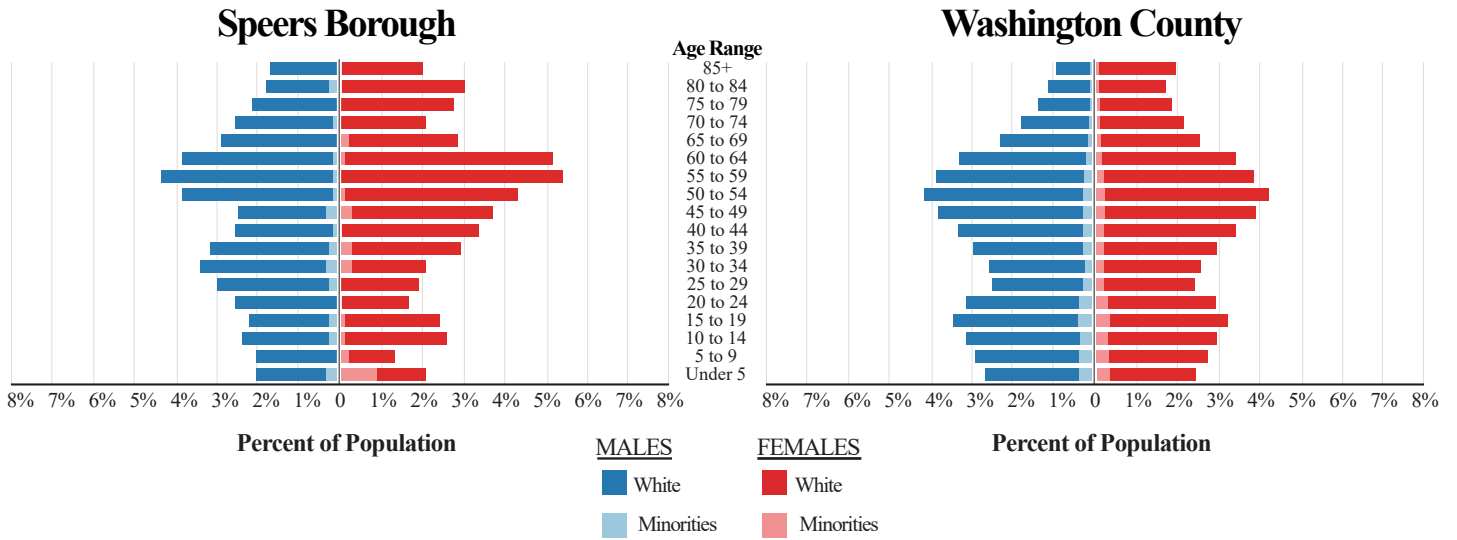

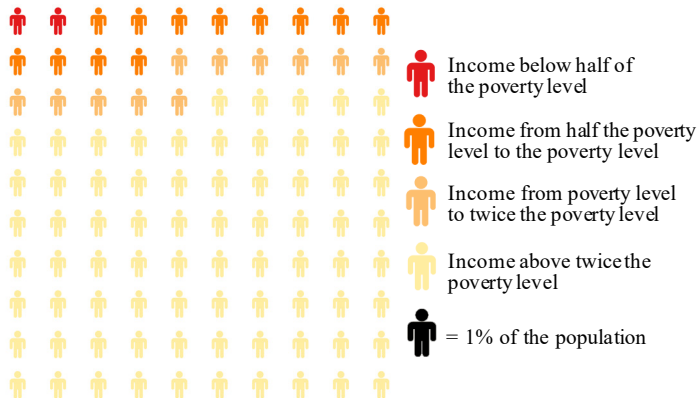

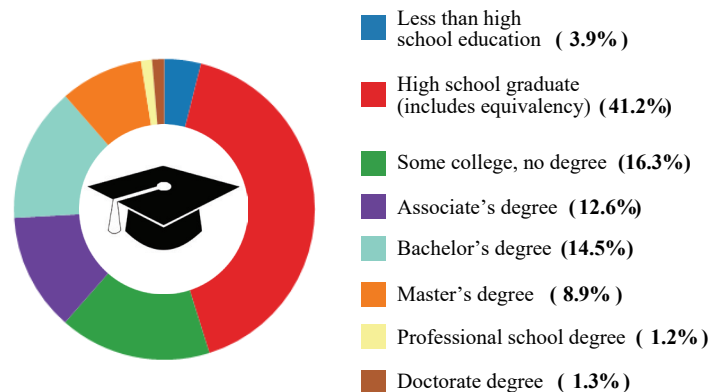
50. Population Distribution By Age

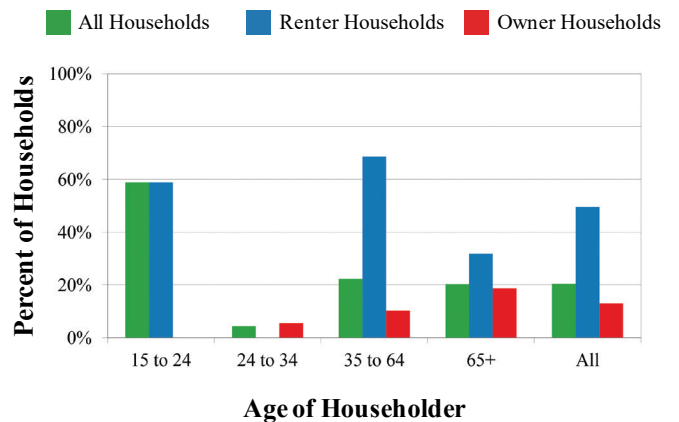
