

Homewood Pedestrian, Student, & Transit Connectivity Project

Description: The Homewood Pedestrian, Student, & Transit Connectivity Project builds upon community priorities and the Urban Redevelopment Authority’s Homewood TOD Study of 2015, which examined possible infrastructure improvements to initiate Transit Oriented Development in the neighborhood. The primary project area is bounded by Hamilton Ave. to the north, Braddock Ave. to the East, N. Homewood Ave. to the west, and the East Busway to the south.

The project improves existing, and creates new multi-modal connections and facilities near the East Busway Homewood station, Faison elementary school, and regional employment and education centers. It will improve safety and accessibility for transit users with the construction of new transit shelters and street furniture along Homewood Ave. at the Busway and Hamilton Ave., and will also improve lighting in the Homewood and N. Braddock Ave underpass. Traffic calming measures will be implemented on Finance St., and various locations will see new, repaired, and widened sidewalks, and the installation of crosswalks, sharrows, and other complete streets components.
