

S. Braddock Ave. Pedestrian Improvements

Description: In April of 2014, SPC conducted a Road Safety Audit of the S. Braddock Avenue corridor, which resulted in a number of recommendations that would increase safety for pedestrian and bicycle traffic while also increasing access to public transportation, community activity centers, and businesses. The S. Braddock Ave. Pedestrian Improvement project will implement a variety of these recommendations to create a safer and more efficient corridor.

South Braddock Avenue is owned jointly by Edgewood and Swissvale Borough. As such, the two municipalities will work cooperatively to develop and administer the project. Differentiated crosswalk markings, electronic speed minder signs and proper pedestrian signals will increase the safety of those crossing the busy roadway, while also alerting motorists to the presence of pedestrians and speed limitations.

The project area is on South Braddock Avenue, from the intersection with West Hutchinson Ave. to the intersection of McClure Street.
