

Wynn and Clara Tredway Trail Extension

Description: Allegheny Township has proposed to further develop the Wynn and Clara Tredway Trail along the Allegheny River. The initial phase of the project began with the development of approximately 1/3 of the Tredway Trail. In 2011, the Township purchased an additional 1.5 miles in an effort to extend the greenway. The proposed project entails development of this next phase of the trail, extending the Tredway Trail to the Freeport Bridge. The Township has recently acquired the final third segment, from the Freeport Bridge to the Kiski River.

The land where the proposed Tredway Trail Extension is situated was historically utilized as a railroad line. Specifically, the project is situated along the miles of corridor along the Township's border with the Allegheny River and the confluences of the Kiski River. The rail bed has since been abandoned creating the opportunity for a riverfront greenway. Allegheny Township will develop an extension of the Tredway Trail along this corridor to provide public recreational use for pedestrians and bikers.

Allegheny Township has already devoted significant resources to the initial two mile trail development and the acquisition of the land for this extension project.
