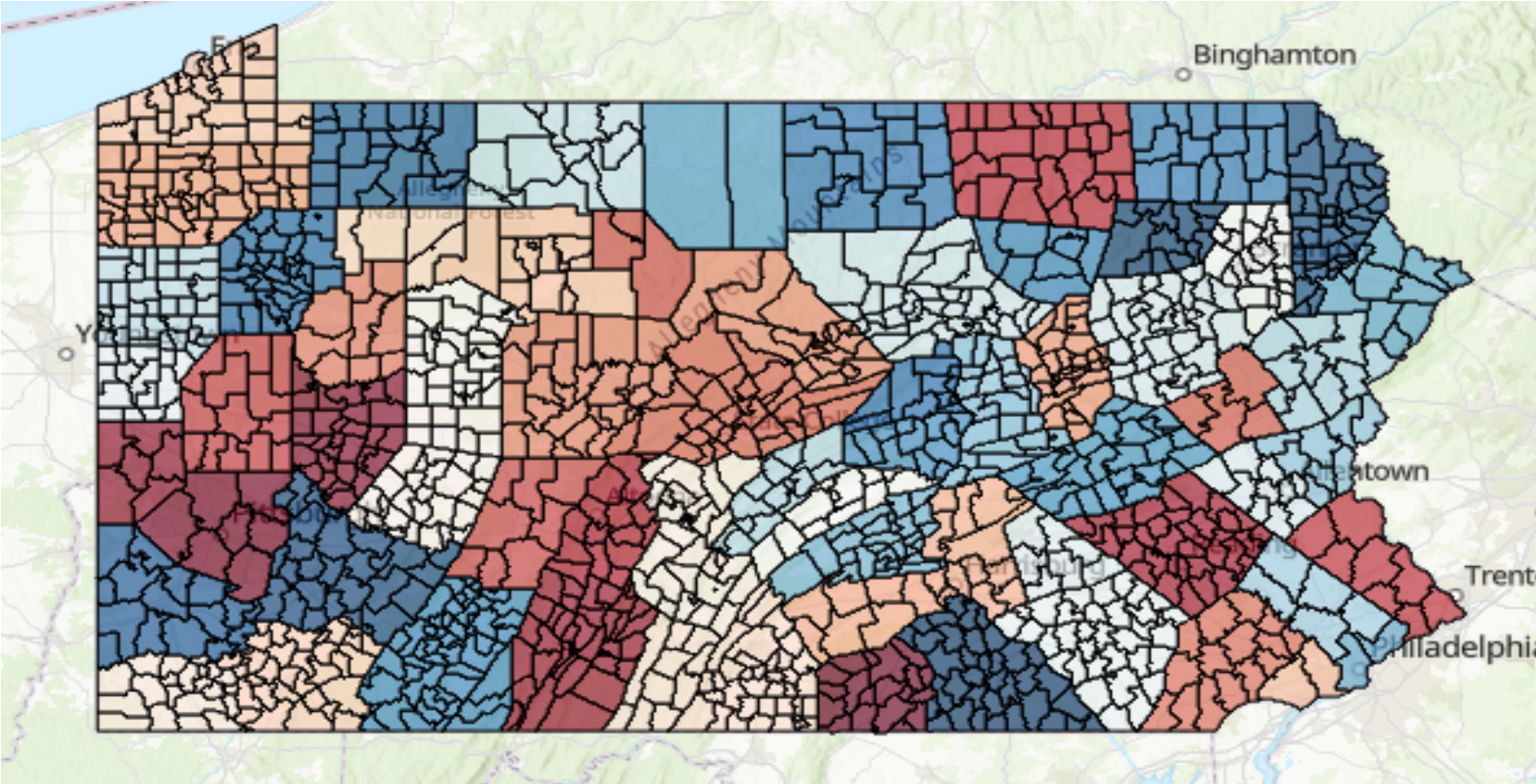
Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program (BEAD) Updates from PBDA

- The Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority (PBDA) is waiting for NTIA approval of location data as a result of the challenge process. Once that has been approved, PBDA can begin to solicit applications for the **\$1.16 billion in funding** PA has been allocated.
- There will be **two 60-day rounds** of application solicitation. Anticipate **Fall '24 & Spring '25**.
- Awards will be subject to approval of final package by NTIA.
- Fiber is preferred technology – but encourage all to apply in first round. Can look at funding others in second round.
- Pennsylvania Broadband Map – BEAD page – identifies BSA's and estimated costs.
- PBDA will work with applicants to ensure all BSA's are served.

PBDA BEAD Process

- Prefers scalable technology and open access.
 - Requires at least 100 Mbps download speed and upload speeds of at least 20 Mbps.
 - Scalability important with download and upload asymmetry
- ISPs are encouraged to partner with county or local governments.
 - Requires a minimum 25% match for funds.
